SUBJECT: GLOBAL POV CONTRACT IMPLEMENTATION UPDATE AND PLANNING GUIDANCE

1. This advisory provides information for all DoD Service members, civilian employees, Service Headquarters and Transportation Offices regarding the implementation of the new Global Privately-owned vehicle Contract III (GPC III). American Auto Logistics (AAL) contract will terminate on 30 April 2014. Effective 1 May 2014, International Auto Logistics (IAL) will become the new Global POV provider. There will be NO break in service available for customers needing to turn-in or pick up a vehicle; however, there will be a short transition period during which we will request assistance in minimizing the volume of vehicles being turned-in at specific locations.

2. With a change in contractors, several issues need to be managed and communicated to ensure a smooth transition for our customers. This advisory is aimed at addressing these issues, providing key information and soliciting your support. Items of interest include: establishment of new Vehicle Processing Centers (VPCs) under the new contract, implementation details and transition planning for our customers.

3. The following CONUS VPCs operated by IAL will be available 1 May to accept vehicles. Please note that these new IAL commercially operated VPCs are located at different addresses.

6. The following OCONUS VPCs operated by IAL will be available 1 May 2014 to accept the turn-in of vehicles. To aid in transition, the Services are urged to ask customers to only drop off vehicles at these facilities on an emergency basis on 1 and 2 May 2014. Reduced traffic on these dates will provide additional time for the previous contractor to vacate the facility, and the new contractor to ensure that each facility is fully operational. Again, IAL will have representatives at these facilities to in process and store emergent vehicles only. These locations will be fully operational on 5 May 2014.
