**Subject:** POV Authorization for Unaccompanied Members Assigned to Turkey

**Purpose:** To remind MAJCOMs, JPPSOs, PPSOs, and PPPOs that unaccompanied members assigned to locations within Turkey are only authorized one POV on their Turkish Customs records, and motorcycles and mopeds are classified as POVs.

**Be Advised:** There have been several cases where an unaccompanied member shipped a motorcycle in their HHG and also shipped a POV through a VPC. This resulted in the unaccompanied member having to pay out-of-pocket to re-ship one POV back to the origin, creating an unnecessary and costly expense.

**Action:** PPPO/PPSOs must ensure unaccompanied members:

1. Are briefed what is in the Personal Property Consignment Instruction Guide (PPCIG) for Turkey.
2. Understand that motorcycles and mopeds are classified as POVs even if shipped in their HHG.
3. Understand that if a motorcycle is shipped in their HHG, a POV cannot be shipped through a VPC and vice versa.
