Subject: Restriction of Privately Owned Vehicles (POV) Shipments to Incirlik Air Base, Turkey

1. Effective immediately, the Air Force has imposed a POV shipping restriction to Incirlik AB, Turkey, until further notice IAW the JTR, paragraph 5330-C. Do not ship POVs to Incirlik. This will affect all service members and DoD Civilians assigned to Incirlik Turkey.
2. POVs staged at Incirlik VPC will remain in country until further directions are provided. POVs in the transportation pipeline to Incirlik will continue to transit to destination.
3. POVs currently staged at the Origin Vehicle Processing Center will not be transported to Incirlik. These customers will be contacted and provided an option to have the POV stored at government expense or picked-up by a dependent or designated representative through an informal letter of authorization or power of attorney. Note: DoD civilian employees are not authorized POV Storage.
4. Personnel assigned to any US Forces activity in Izmir, Turkey (including NATO) are not affected. Personnel assigned to Eskisehir, Turkey are not authorized a shipment of a POV.
